Subject: Offering of “Star Utsav” channel free of charge on a a-la-carte basis.

Ref:

1. Subscription License Agreement executed between you (“**DPO**”) and Star India Private Limited (“**Star**”) along with the amendments/interim extension letters issued (if any) (collectively the “**SLA**”)
2. Letter No. 2/21/2020-BP&L (Part II) dated March 30, 2020 issued by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting to all Distribution Platform Operators (“**DPOs**”) (“**MIB Circular**”).

Dear Sir,

This is in reference to MIB Circular issued with an intent to encourage viewers to remain indoors to break this chain of transmission of COVID 19 in the country. As per the MIB Circular, we are pleased to inform you that Star has agreed to offer its channel “Star Utsav” (“**Channel**”) free of charge on a-la-carte basis, for a period of two months with effect from April 1, 2020 (“**Effective Date**”). The details during such offer period are as under:

Channel	Star Utsav
Offer Period	2 months (April 1, 2020 to May 31, 2020)
MRP of Channel during the Offer Period	NIL per subscriber per month who have subscribed to the Channel on a-la-carte basis (applicable to Addressable Platforms i.e., DTH, HITS, IPTV & DAS Operators)

In light of the MIB Circular, you are requested to offer the Channel, during the Offer Period without any increase in subscription directly or indirectly to all the consumers who have subscribed the channel on a-la carte basis. Needless to mention that the MRP of the Channel as referred in the SLA shall be applicable post expiry of the aforesaid Offer Period.

Except to the extent provided above, all other terms and conditions of the SLA along with the terms of amendment agreements/ interim extension letters, if any, shall continue to remain binding for the remaining part of the Term of SLA.
